1. ANNOUNCEMENT & JURISDICTION

The AJSMCC, GMCC, BMCC, LMCC, BSA&HD MC & CMCC and the WAMX Committee known as the PROMOTERS, will conduct the meetings in accordance with the GENERAL COMPETITION RULES OF MOTORCYCLING AUSTRALIA, these supplementary regulations & any additions or amendments approved by MWA.

2. OFFICIALS

Officials are appointed with the approval of the Senior Sub Committee and MWA. Control will be under the Clerk of Course with the supervision from the Steward/s of the meeting who reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the event program if required, without notice.

3. ELIGIBLE CLASSES & EVENTS

3.1 STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS. ANY RIDER MAY ENTER A CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS. Preference given to those with a higher grade State Championship events will be contested for each solo & Quad machine capacity class as follows: -

- § Pro-Lite Championship: 125cc + 250cc 4 stroke 2 Heats of 15 mins + 1 lap, 1 x 6 Lap Sprint
- § Pro-Open Championship: 126cc to 500cc 2 str. + 280cc to 650cc 4 str. 2 Heats of 15 mins + 1 lap, 1 x 6 Lap Sprint
- § Quad Racer Championship: Up to 550cc 2 stroke + up to 700cc 4 stroke 3 x 10 mins + 1 lap

3.2 SUPPORT CLASSES may be conducted at promoter's discretion

Intermediate Open and Intermediate Lites 3 x 10 mins plus 1 lap

Intermediate Quad Racers 3 x 10mins + 1 Lap {run with Pro Quads}

Veteran class (35 yrs & over, no pro class riders) and Pro Veterans (Pro and Intermediate riders over 35). Both classes will be run together and scored separately. 3 x 4 laps

Clubman Lites class and Clubman Open 3 x 4 laps

Quad Racer Clubman Up to 550cc 2 stroke + up to 700cc 4 stroke 3 x 4 laps

Any consolation/qualifying races will be 4 laps.

3.3 PLATE COLOURS

Plate colours are as per the GCR's

Plate colours will apply to all capacity classes. Side plates must be the same colour as front plates. Riders must display a back number in contrasting colours at all times (refer GCR's).

3.4 TRANSPONDERS:

Transponders will be compulsory at this meeting. Transponders can be purchased through MWA, or hired for \$10.00 per day.

It is compulsory to have purchased and fitted a transponder bracket prior to this meeting. Transponder brackets are available for purchase for \$15.00 through MWA.

You must supply your own cable ties.

Condition of entry:

- When a transponder is transferred to the competitor, it is the competitor's responsibility for any repairs or replacement cost of the transmitter if damaged or lost.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure the transponder is mounted correctly, and securely to prevent damage from fouling other components on the machine.
- It is the competitor's responsibility transponders are returned in good condition at the end of the event, or if due to machine failure or injury before the machine leaves the pit area. **Competitors WILL be fined \$50 for not returning transponders on the day.**
- Transponders must be returned to the designated person as advised at the riders briefing.
- For transponders not returned on the same day, or not returned to the designated person, in addition to the \$50 fee, the hirer is responsible for the transponder until it arrives back at the MWA office. This includes while in transit with Australia Post and by Courier. No excuse will be entertained for non-delivery. It is recommended transponders be hand-delivered.
- Transponders must be fitted for all practice sessions.

NOTE: The onus is on guardian/rider to ensure transponders are on machines prior to each event.

6. MINIMUM / MAXIMUM RIDERS

6.1 STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

As per the 2007 G.C.R 7.6.1.3, the maximum number of entries that will be accepted per class is forty, (40), except the quad-racer class where it will be twenty, (20) as per G.C.R. 12.6.1.3(c). The minimum number of starters required to constitute a championship race is ten, (10) for all classes. Except quads where the minimum number of starters required to constitute a championship race is eight (8). If more than forty entries are received qualifying racers will decide the competitors whom may compete in the state championship racers. Except for quads, if more than twenty, (20) entries are received for quads qualifying will also take place to decide the competitors whom will compete in the state championship racers. For the purpose of qualifying only, practice may be timed and used for qualifying. I.E. top 5 riders seeded and the fastest 35 (15 in Quads) lap times will qualify. All competitors who fail to qualify are entitled to ride in the support races.

6.2 SEEDED RIDERS

6.2.1 The top five riders in the 2006 Pro-Lite Championships will be automatically seeded into the Pro-Lite Championship class for the first round only.

6.2.2 The top five riders in the 2006 Pro-Open state motocross championships will be automatically seeded into the pro-open class for the first round only.

6.2.3 The top five quad riders in 2006 Quad Racer championships will be automatically seeded into the quad-racer class for the first round only.

At all remaining rounds, the 5 riders with the overall highest points will be automatically seeded into their respective classes.

6.3 SUPPORT CLASS

The minimum number of entries required to constitute any of the support classes is eight, (8) competitors.

7. ENTRY FEES & CONDITIONS

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

Entries will officially close **Ten (10) days prior to each championship round.** However, entries **will be accepted up to Five (5) days prior to each round** but with the penalty of **double the entry fee.** Under no circumstances will any late entries be accepted after this final date. **Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted and will be returned to the entrant. To be eligible for a refund, you must notify the race secretary before the event and have a legitimate reason. NO EXCEPTIONS. All refunds will be paid at the end of the series.**

7.1 FEES

Series Entries

If a rider wishes to enter all six rounds the total cost will be;

	\$300 For Clubman Classes (\$50.00) per round)
	\$270 For Veterans/Pro Vets (\$45.00) per round)

Transponder fee will be \$10.00 per round (or \$60 Series) for all classes.

Individual round entries.

Competitors entering in more than one class must pay the full entry fee for each class as listed above.

i.e. Prolite + Pro open championship capacity classes = \$720 for series or \$130.00 per round

7.2 ENTRY CONDITIONS:

All entries must be correctly submitted on the MWA Entry Form, stating the correct capacity and grade. The entry form and the indemnity clauses must be signed. **Entry fees must accompany entry form or entry will NOT be accepted, NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Competitors must be current registered members of the affiliated club as listed on their MA national competition licence. Competitors must be able to produce proof of current club membership. Club membership cards or receipts must be presented with the competition licence at machine examination for inspection.

Interstate riders must include documented proof of their current grading from their LCB. Interstate riders can receive prize money but no points will be awarded.

The promoters reserve the right to refuse any unacceptable entry.

If under any circumstances the event is abandoned, or an entry is not accepted, all entry fees will be returned. The promoters reserve the right to postpone, cancel, or change the programme, if necessary, with MAWA approval prior to the meeting, or with permission from the MA Steward on the day of the meeting. Control will be under the Clerk of Course with supervision from the Steward whose interpretation of the rules shall be binding and final.

8. MACHINE EXAMINATION

Pits will open 6.30am. **Machine Examination will commence at 6.30am and conclude at 7.55am**

At each round, all machines entered in the competition are to be successfully passed through machine examination prior to taking part in official activities. **All competitors must present themselves with their MA license, proof of current club membership listed on their license and full riding gear for inspection. Any machine not presented with all of the above requirements will be rejected! ALL MACHINES MUST CONFORM TO THE GENERAL COMPETITION RULES.** Machines may be measured, bore & stroke for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place getters. The Steward and Clerk of Course will be responsible for the decision to measure machines that day. Any machine may be measured at the request of the Steward or under protest.

NO SMOKING IN THE PIT OR CANTEN AREAS

BIKES TO BE WASHED IN DESIGNATED WASH AREAS AS OUTLINED BY EACH HOST CLUB. RIDERS WITH PRESSURE CLEANERS TO SUPPLY THEIR OWN WATER DRUMS TO FREE UP HOSES FOR RIDERS WISHING TO HAND WASH THEIR MACHINES. (Drums can be filled before event or when hoses are free)

Noise Testing

To ensure compliance with GCR's and local environment regulations regular noise testing will be conducted at Motorcycling WA events.

Machines may be tested for noise at this event. The stroke of your machine must be supplied on the attached entry form. Failure to supply the stroke of your machine if required to be noised tested, may result in exclusion from this event.

Please ensure your machine has a properly packed muffler and all after market exhausts meet the maximum noise levels as per GCR regulations.

9. RACE CONDITIONS

9.1 START/FINISH METHOD

For the allocation of championship points, the championship races must be of the prescribed duration for the Prolite/Pro open classes and 10 mins + 1 lap for the Quad class.

Riders are not permitted on the start grid until authorized by the officials. Only riders and officials are allowed at the starting gate from the moment the first rider is placed in position.

Grid selection: Heat 1 - Rider to select a peg. Peg 1 = first selection of all gates, peg 25 = 25th selection of gates etc.

Grid selection: Remaining heats - Riders will select their gate as per the finishing order of the previous heat. i.e. 1st place = 1st selection of ALL gates, 25th placing = 25th selection of remaining gates.

9.1.1 Method of Start - Mass start with engines running.

Machines shall be placed on the starting line.

The starter will hold up a green flag, and from this moment the riders are under his control.

At the completion of the two (2) minutes the starter will:

- Hold up a Fifteen (15) second board for a full Fifteen (15) seconds.
- At the end of Fifteen (15) seconds, a five (5) second board will be displayed.
- The gate will then drop between five (5) to ten (10) seconds after the five (5) second board is shown

9.1.2 Method of Finish - At the completion of the allotted time for each class, the leading rider is to be shown a ONE lap board indicating that ONE lap remains. The chequered flag is displayed to signal the race is completed.

10. PRACTICE

Practice for all championship classes will be as follows. Riders will only have one (1) practice each, except for those riding two (2) separate capacity machines.

The order of practice and number of laps for each class will be as follows:

§ Clubman Lite	3 laps
§ Quad Clubman	3 laps
§ Quad Championship/Inters	5 laps
§ Clubman Open	3 laps
§ Veterans/Pro Veterans Support	3 laps
§ Pro-Lite Championship/ inters	5 laps
§ Pro-Open Championship / Inters	5 laps

Practice classes may be combined.

Practice Starts: will only be permitted during official practice however no practice starts will be permitted after the last lap board is displayed. Riders must leave the track via the pit return or as directed by the Clerk of Course.

11. CHANGE OF MACHINE

Change of machine is permitted in either of the Championship or Support events as per GCR's on the condition that notification must be in the hands of the Clerk of Course at least 10 minutes prior to the race in which the substitution is to be made and further, that the replacement machine must have been correctly entered, examined and passed at machine examination. Machine change must be of same capacity.

12. CROSSING THE CIRCUIT

Competitors are reminded that crossing the circuit during racing or practice is strictly prohibited.

13. MECHANICS' AREA

This is the only area where mechanics can get trackside to signal their riders, and if necessary, assist with mechanical problems without being penalized. Change of goggles/gloves is permitted in this area only. Riders will be advised of this area at the riders meeting.

14. ABSENTEEISM & MALINGERING

In accordance with the GCR's any rider who enters for any competition and who fails to be present at the start must advise either the Steward or WAMX of the scratching and submit a reasonable explanation or a penalty may be imposed by MWA.

15. DOPING TESTS

All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any of these events in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800020506

16. INSURANCE

The National Personal Accident policy provides basic cover for death and permanent disability. Additional insurance is the responsibility of individuals. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.**

17. PITS

"Closed pits" will be in operation at each round. Competitors are to comply with the requests of hosting clubs as to parking and machine scrutineering. Competitors are to push their machines to and from the start marshalling area.

§ **STRICTLY NO RIDING OF BIKES IN THE PIT AREA**

§ **STRICTLY NO ALCOHOL IN THE PITS**

§ **DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE CIRCUIT**

§ **COMPETITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN CONDUCT AS WELL AS THE CONDUCT OF ANY PERSON ASSOCIATED WITH THEM.**

18. PRIZEMONEY

Minimum prize money will be calculated on OVERALL points gained at each round. **Points will be scored, as per GCR 5.8.9.** The race secretary will distribute the prize money applicable to each round.

Sponsors product may also be given to riders at random.

19. FIRST AID

St John Ambulance personnel will be in attendance.

It is a condition of entry that First Aid **MUST** be accepted wherever deemed necessary by the attending first aides. The Steward of the day has the right to refuse further racing of a rider if first aide requirements are not adhered to.

20. NO HASSLE POLICY

Any rider or entrant or person associated with the rider or entrant shall conduct himself or herself in an orderly manner. A rider shall be responsible for his own conduct and that of any person with whom he is associated. Anyone who abuses or threatens personally or physically any official or any other person present at the event shall be deemed to be in Breach of this rule.

The Steward for a breach of this rule may impose PENALTIES on the day of this meeting i.e.:

*Reprimand or warning.

*Fine.

*Expulsion from the meeting.

All breaches will be reported to MAWA for possible further action.

21. GENERAL RULES

No alcoholic beverages allowed in pits or racing circuit.

There will be no riding of bikes other than on the track.

Machines must be pushed to and from vehicles and in and out of the pits. Engine may be running to assist.

Dogs will not be permitted (except guide dogs).

Machines must remain in pits for the duration of the days racing, unless permission has been granted by the Steward to remove the machine. Riders of machines removed without authority may be excluded and all points forfeited for the day's event and/or incur a fine of up to \$100.00. Enclosed footwear must be worn in the pits at all times.

NO pushbikes, quads, pit bikes or scooters permitted within the premises.

Full canteen and bar will be running.

- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- "Indemnities" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

3. I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
 - that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- the Indemnities do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

- Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:
 - rendered with due care and skill;
 - as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
 - reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. 7. A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

MEDICAL

I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnities will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

9. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnities (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnities and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

PRIVACY

10. I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the **WAMX & AJSMC GMCC BMCC LMCC BS&HDMC CMCC**, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by **WAMX & AJSMC GMCC BMCC LMCC BS&HDMC CMCC**, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by **WAMX & AJSMC GMCC BMCC LMCC BS&HDMC CMCC** by contacting **WAMX & AJSMC GMCC BMCC LMCC BS&HDMC CMCC** at 25/168 Guildford Rd Maylands or MA at 147 Montague St, South Melbourne, Victoria, 3205. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

11. I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

- I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
 - If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at Item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information;
 - MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving the safety of MA and SCB events and of the Meeting organisers and facility providers of MA / SCB permitted events, and generally to reduce the risks to persons engaged in motorcycle sport; and

POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

12. I acknowledge, understand and agree that it is a condition of my participation in the Event that I agree to be bound by, and subject to, the rules, regulations and jurisdiction of MA as amended from time to time. Copies of all MA rules, policies and regulations are available by contacting the MA office.

13. All participants are bound by the MA anti doping policy and thus understand they may be subject to drug testing. Testing conducted by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) is in accordance with the ASADA Act and the National Anti-Doping Scheme. This involves the taking of a sample (any human biological fluid or tissue whether alive or otherwise, or any human breath) for the purpose of detecting the use of a Prohibited Drug or Doping Method. Any participant infringing MA's policy or refusing a drug test may be disqualified or otherwise dealt with in accordance with the terms of the anti-doping policy.
